

## IMPRESSIVE PROGRESS FOR PUPILS AT MEATH SCHOOL

The DfE has collected information on progress over Key Stage 2 (8 – 11 year olds) for all SEN pupils. Meath School has used the information to compare the progress of our pupils from the end of KS1 to the end of KS2 (Year 6)

The upper quartile is the highest performing 25% of SEN pupils and is outstanding performance

The average percentage of Year 6 pupils in the Upper Quartile showing outstanding progress across all subject strands for 2016 was **84%**.
