

## **Pupil Premium Fund Impact 2017-18**

We have four pupils eligible for Free School Meals; we currently receive Pupil Premium funding for two of them. The children who we do not yet receive funding for joined the school relatively recently. One was entered on the January 2017 Census as being eligible. We continue to seek clarification from their LA as to where this funding is being used. The other pupil will be entered on the January 2018 census.

**Child 1:** The pupil premium is received on a termly basis for child 1. The (2017/18) money will be used to fund a weekly overnight stay and after school activities to enable them to develop and practice language, social and life skills learnt in school, in less formal settings. Occupational and speech and language therapy programmes continue to be delivered and developed in a less structured environment extending skills in these areas. Progress will be monitored using the nfer Nelson Insight Primary Self-Esteem indicator and using the Meath School Residential Life Skills Programme.

**Child 2:** Stays for breakfast club via pupil premium funding, which also supports swimming lessons (Woking Leisure Centre), and any after school activities.
